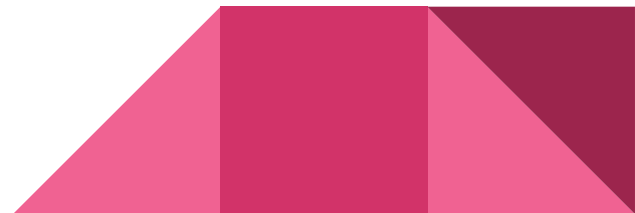
Last Weeks Meeting We...

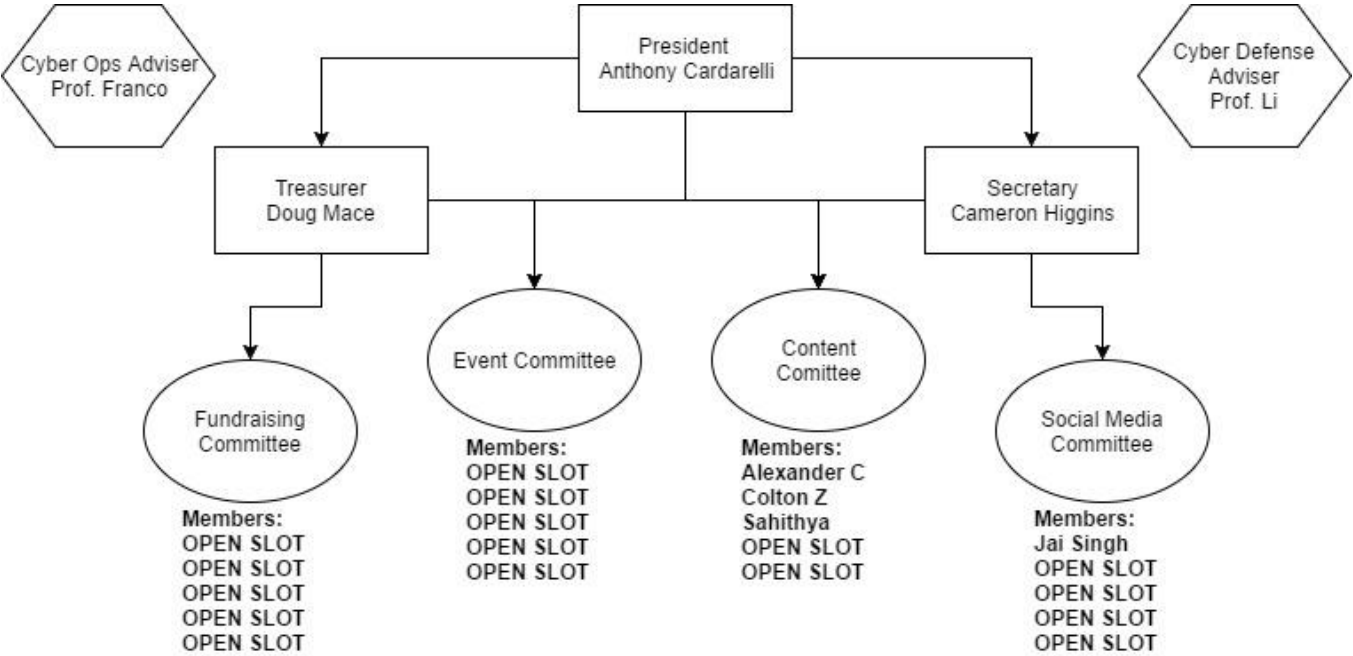
